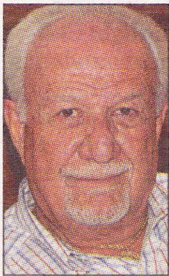
## Top Realtors announced

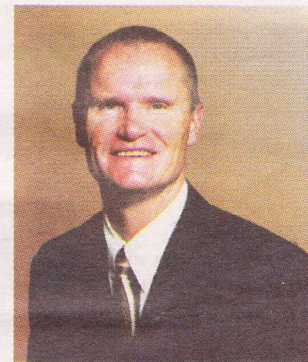
